Safety plan for worship at Augustana Lutheran Church

Worship March 14, 2021

- 1. As you come into our worship space.
 - a. Attendees will be asked to take a self-assessment of how they feel
 - b. A thermometer will be available to identify a fever.
 - c. A log will be kept as part of the plan to notify anyone if a Covid-19 positive result happens.
 - d. If you are not feeling well please stay home.
- 2. Masks over mouth and nose will be required at all times, (including those that have received the COVID Vaccine) before, during, and after worship.
- 3. Please Social Distance 6 ft. apart as you enter and exit the Church. There are 6 ft. markers on the floor.
- 4. There will be no gathering in the narthex as people are asked to go right to a seat that is open.
- 5. People who live in the same house or interact regularly may sit together.
- 6. **People from different households** must sit in different pews.

Worship will be

- 1. Shortened
- 2. Masks are required over nose and mouth at all times.
- 3. No congregational singing will happen, however as more is known and regulations loosen we will add this.
- 4. Communion will be weekly, wafer only, no wine at this time.
- 5. Pastor will serve communion at your seat.
- 6. We will attempt to have zoom worship at the same time.
- 7. Votive candles by the Columbarium have been temporarily removed.

Misc.

- 1. The only **Bathroom** being used at this time will be the handicap bathroom downstairs, which will be accessed using the back staircase. (front staircase will be blocked off)
- 2. Front door and windows will be open at all times for circulation.
- 3. Hand sanitizers and masks will be available, however we ask that people bring their own mask and hand sanitizer.
- 4. NO food or drink
- 5. There will be **No Coffee Hour.**

Signs and information will be posted everywhere in the building to help people follow the instructions on how to navigate in this "new normal".
